



FULVISOL 10%

CONCENTRATED FULVIC ACID LIQUID

THE PRODUCT

Fulvisol 10% is a liquid concentrate fulvic acid that can be added to fertiliser to assist with plant uptake via its natural complexing properties. It can also act as a carbon source for soil microorganisms when applied to soil and assist with germination.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- This product can be added to a range of granular or liquid fertilisers or applied as a concentrate.
- This product is also available as a soluble powder. Contact Sipcam for more details.
- When tank-mixing, add product to the solution after all other products (including most of the water) have been added and incorporated.
- If local experience of successful use is unavailable, conduct a jar test before widespread use. Do not continue with application if any issues are observed.
- Do not apply close to harvest, as fruit staining can occur.
- Do not apply by foliar application to stone fruit.
- Do not apply by foliar application to flowers or fruit of any crop.

COMPATIBILITY

Compatible with most common fertilisers and crop protection products. It is recommended to conduct a jar test before mixing.

FORMULATION: Fulvisol 10% is a concentrated liquid containing 10% fulvic acid.

APPLICATION METHOD	RATE	COMMENTS
Foliar (all crops)	1 – 5 L per 100 L water	It is recommended to add last to tank mixes. Check compatibility before adding to crop protection products. Do not apply close to harvest, as fruit staining is possible.
Fertigation (all crops)	3 – 10 L/ha	Apply through fertigation system.
Seed treatment	5 L/t	Apply during seed cleaning.
Turf establishment	10 L/ha	Apply immediately after planting with started fertiliser.
Turf maintenance	Apply 2 L per 100 L to a rate of 5 to 10 L/ha	Apply via boom or fertigation system.
